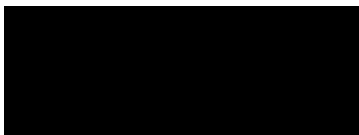
Re: A30 Chiverton to Carland Cross HBMCE Response to Examining Authority's Questions
