- Notification by statutory parties of wish to be considered as an Interested Party

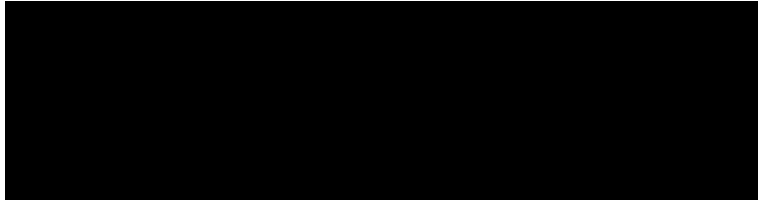

Location	Justification
Bickenhill SSSI	The Council wishes to highlight the location of the designated site in relation to the DCO, and its unique features.
Aspbury's Copse, Scheduled Ancient Woodland	The Council wishes to highlight the location of the designated site in relation to the DCO, and its unique features.
Views towards the Bickenhill Church of St Peter (Grade 1 Listed) from Catherine de Barnes Lane	The Council wishes to emphasise the Church's continued notable presence on the local high point, rising above all surrounding buildings.
Views towards Hampton in Arden Conservation Area and its Grade II* Listed Clock Tower from footpath ID:M123 running north from Hampton Lane Farm on Solihull Road	The Council wishes to highlight the current setting of the Conservation Area
A number of viewpoints identified on Figure 8.1 Viewpoint Location Plan Sheet 1 of 2; J, K, L, Q, R, T, Z, EE, FF.	The Council considers these receptors will experience large adverse effects during construction, winter year one and summer year 15.
A45 Coventry Road from Clock Tower to M42 Junction 6	This area is subject to 2 ministerial directions in terms of air quality; the Council has concerns that the DCO will adversely affect air quality in the

	vicinity during both construction and operational phases.
