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#### 1 Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared in respect of the proposed M42 Junction 6
  Development Consent Order ("the Application") made by Highways England
  Company Limited ("Highways England") to the Secretary of State for Transport
  (Secretary of State) for a Development Consent Order ("the Order") under section
  37 of the Planning Act 2008 ("PA 2008").
- 1.1.2 Highways England and Mr Philip O'Reilly have been engaged in consultation and a record of engagement has been prepared in association with the DCO Examination for the M42 Junction 6.
- 1.1.3 This record of engagement has been prepared by Highways England following a request by The Examining Authority, at the Open Floor Hearing on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019.



### 2 Record of engagement with Mr O'Reilly

2.1.1 The parties have been engaged in consultation since the beginning of the proposed development. A summary of the meetings and correspondence that has taken place between Highways England and Mr O'Reilly of Four Winds in relation to the Application is outlined in Table 1.1.

Highways England (HE) offered to arrange a specific appointment with members of the Project Team at one of the consultation events, if requested by Mr O'Reilly.
	Email	Mr O'Reilly requested clarification that all of the Project Team will be at both St. Peters Church Hall and Fentham Hall events, as those would be the most likely dates that he would be able to attend.
05.01.18	Email	Confirmation that HE land and compensation staff will be available at the two events that Mr O'Reilly queried in his email (12.12.17) and follow up email (04.01.18), in addition to the WGAA in Bickenhill on 27.01.18. HE offered Mr O'Reilly a separate meeting at his convenience to discuss the scheme and potential impacts on Four Winds.
09.01.18	Statutory Consultation	Commencement of statutory consultation and the publication of a Scheme layout plan (ref-HE551485-ACM-HGN-M42_SW_ZZ_ZZ-DR-CH-002). A copy of this plan can be found in Appendix B.
31.01.18	Email	Query regarding why Ardent are requesting ownership details of Four Winds, having previously submitted details in December 2017.
16.02.18	Email	Response from Ardent on behalf of HE in relation to Mr O'Reilly's query outlined in his email on 31.01.18. Explanation that the additional RFI that was sent to Mr O'Reilly was due to the need to ascertain whether there are any additional interests in the land/property that could be entitled to a compensation claim, but not subject to any potential land take. If there are no further interests in Four Winds, there is no requirement to return the second RFI to Ardent.



19.03.18	Phone call	Phone call from Mr O'Reilly requesting a
		progress update. It was explained that the consultation period had ended on 9th March and HE were in the process of considering responses. A meeting was suggested for a few weeks' time. It was explained that further work was being undertaken regarding the WGAA relocation. Mr O'Reilly asked if HE would fund an agent to represent him which HE will respond to in due course.
04.09.18	Further Consultation	Commencement of further consultation and publication of a scheme layout plan (ref-HE551485-ACM-HGN-M42_SW_ZZ_ZZ-DR-CH-0014), scheme changes plan (ref- HE551485-ACM-HGN-M42_GEN_ZZ_Z-DR-CH-0014) and a redline boundary plan (ref- HE551485-ACM-HGN-M42_GEN_ZZ_Z-DR-CH-0013). Copies of these plans can be found in Appendix B.
21.09.18	Meeting	Mr O'Reilly provided a written list of concerns regarding the scheme. Discussions were formed around the WGAA plans and reasons why relocation of the club was no longer a viable option. Alternative access options were also discussed. Actions from the meeting included the circulation of points of concern articulated by Mr O'Reilly to the wider project team.
30.10.18	Email	Request from Mr O'Reilly for an update on addressing points raised in the meeting of 21.09.18, and an update on options discussed between HE and WGAA.
07.11.18	Email	Response to Mr O'Reilly's email of 30.10.18 with answers to points made by Mr O'Reilly in the meeting on 21.09.18.
13.11.18	Email	Response to HE from Mr O'Reilly regarding the issues from the meeting and a request for information on when drawings will be available for discussion.
21.12.18	Email	Response to Mr O'Reilly's email detailing issues and image of a plan to show what a revised access could look like in detail. A copy of this plan is shown in Appendix A.
	Email	Question from Mr O'Reilly regarding access.
04.01.19	Email	Plan showing a potential revised access to Four Winds shared with Mr O'Reilly.
	Email	Request for dates to arrange meeting with HE.
11.01.19	Email	To arrange meeting with Mr O'Reilly in order to



		give a scheme update on the design and DCO application.
14.01.19	Email	Request from Mr O'Reilly for details of the WGAA options to be forwarded prior to the meeting on 25th January 2019.
25.01.19	Meeting	Meeting to discuss overview of previous communication between the two parties, the proposals for the options being discussed with the WGAA, an update on the DCO application submission and other scheme matters. It was explained to Mr O'Reilly that the provision of option drawings was not practicable until discussions with the WGAA had reached a point whereby a formal layout could be agreed. HE provided a timeline of WGAA proposals. Mr O'Reilly expressed his concerns regarding other elements of the scheme including the air quality and noise concerns due to the proposed new roundabout. Actions arising from the meeting included HE to provide further information relating to the WGAA reconfiguration proposals, the consideration of the appropriateness of HE paying for a professional advisor for Mr O'Reilly, HE to review the rear access proposals and confirmation of noise, air quality monitoring in relation to traffic movements at Barbers Coppice Roundabout and potential lighting impacts on Four Winds.
13.02.19	Email	Request by Mr O'Reilly to Highways England to provide an update on the progress made in regard to the WGAA options.
19.02.19	Email	Mr O'Reilly requesting response to email of 13.02.19
01.03.19	Meeting	Meeting to give an update on the scheme and the DCO application. Discussions also occurred regarding the rear access to the Four Winds property and an A1 drawing showing changes made to the access was provided at the meeting. An update was given regarding the WGAA reconfiguration option and potential impacts on Four Winds. Mr O'Reilly also queried why HE had not yet paid for an advisor for him to which HE explained it does not pay for advisors to object to the scheme. Actions raised from the meeting included HE to provide details of the Option I proposal for the WGAA and investigate the potential of suggestion to the WGAA that they could purchase Four Winds via a joint funding agreement with Highways England.
14.03.19	Email	From Mr O'Reilly requesting an up-to-date drawing of the WGAA proposal ahead of the



		meeting on 28.03.19, clarification on the proposals regarding the new clubhouse and car park for the WGAA, and clarification on the land take acquired for the proposed WGAA options.
19.03.19	Email	Provision of draft WGAA Reconfiguration Option I.
22.03.19	Email	Confirmation of revised access proposals and DCO WGAA proposals.
25.03.19	Email	Mr O'Reilly requesting meeting note from the meeting on 01.03.19. Query as to where to find the WGAA design in the DCO documents. Highways England responded with a reply regarding the location of the DCO plans for the WGAA option.
28.03.19	Meeting	Discussion of suggested design amendments at Four Winds, the WGAA Option I (which was previously shared with Mr O'Reilly and the Parish Council) and explanation that HE is in discussion with the WGAA without prejudice regarding a potential legacy scheme. The potential impacts of the legacy scheme on Four Winds were articulated by Mr O'Reilly. Actions arising from the meeting included providing Mr O'Reilly with a CAD drawing of the suggested design changes and HE to seek advice on whether some payment for an advisor for Mr O'Reilly could be facilitated.
29.03.19	Email	HE circulated the CAD drawing requested by Mr O'Reilly at the meeting on 28.03.19.
01.04.19	Email	From Mr O'Reilly with his mark-up on the CAD drawing provided on 29.03.19 setting out his aspirations for the boundary treatment around Four Winds.
02.04.19	Email	Lands policy response to Mr O'Reilly's additional request for costs – response was no, Highways England does not consider the costs in seeking legal advice in order to raise a representation or objection.
30.04.19	Email	From Mr O'Reilly requesting an update on the actions from the meeting on 28.03.19.
20.05.19	Email	Circulation of meeting minutes and explanation that HE should be in a position to confirm the treatment of any accommodation works around Four Winds within a couple of weeks, dependent on the DCO Examination timetable.




