Transport Assessment Supplementary Information Report

Please find attached a Transport Assessment Supplementary Information Report (TASIR), (TR010029/Pre-EXAM/9.5) which provides supplementary information and clarification to that presented in the Transport Assessment Report ([APP-098](#)).

The TASIR comprises the following:

- Amended traffic modelling results due to the inclusion of the extended inter-green phase in the traffic signal timings at the junction of the A12 westbound off-slip with junction 28 roundabout carriageway to reduce delays on Brook Street, which will now be included in the Scheme (Do something scenario),
- Additional information on the traffic impacts of the Scheme on Gallows Corner junction and the A12 between this junction and junction 28 of the M25,
- An assessment of high and low growth assumptions,
- Traffic impacts during construction of the Scheme to reflect the further refinement of the proposed temporary traffic management arrangements.
