Thank you for consulting Natural England as an Interested Party on Change Request 8 (letter attached for our own records).

Natural England agree that, while the increase in percentage of loss of the SMI would be 0.1% above that identified in the Chapter 7 of the Environmental Statement, to 2%. This does not alter the 'slight adverse' effect which is identified in the ES. The changes to the scheme within 'Change 8' fall **within** the scope and assessment of the Environmental Statement.

Natural England offer no opinion on whether or not this constitutes a 'material change' to the proposal.


