Thank you for the opportunity to comment upon REP7-012 Statement of Commonality for Statements of Common Ground May 2021.

I can confirm that LB Havering has reviewed this document and agrees with the majority of the content of the report that relates to LB Havering, with the exception of the position regarding the effects on the highway network from construction and operational issues. This position is currently unshaded (Table 6.1 of REP7-012) and Havering believes should be shown as RED. A number of issues concerning the impact on the local and strategic road network are not agreed as set out in section 10.2 and 10.3 of Table 3.1 on REP7-006 *Statement of Common Ground with London Borough of Havering*.

With regards to the Statement of Common Ground with London Borough of Havering (REP7-006), LBH would wish for section 7.3.1 to be updated to reflect the provision of the NMU route via Brook Street interchange.
