London Borough of Havering (20025659) – LB Havering response to Applicant's comments on London Borough of Havering's Deadline 6 submissions (REP7-020)

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on REP7-020 Applicant's comments on London Borough of Havering's Deadline 6 Submissions. LB Havering would like to make the following comments.

LB Havering notes and welcomes the clarity with regards to REP6 -030 -02 that Highways England will submit a planning application to Havering for the temporary car park for the Gardens of Peace Cemetery.

Havering wishes to retains it's position regarding the need for a Code Of Construction Practice and welcomes the ExA's proposed Requirement for a Code of Construction Practice as set out in the Schedule of ExA's recommended amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO Version 6 (PD-021) which will be the subject of a separate submission by LB Havering.

LB Havering welcomes the production of a Community and Engagement Plan which will be submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 8.

Havering notes the comments made by the Applicant with regards to REP6-034-05 (Proposed Pre Commencement Requirement to include for the production of a Site Construction Management Plan) and Havering maintains its position that it would wish this Requirement to be included in the final DCO should the proposed Requirement for a Code of Construction Practice not be included in the final DCO.

It is noted in the ExA's recommended amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO Version 6 (PD-021) that a New Requirement has been recommended concerning the production of a Code of Construction Practice prior to any part of the authorised development commencing. This is welcome and LB Havering will be responded to (PD-021) separately.

With regards to the provision of noise mitigation measures for the residents of Grove (REP6 -036-04) LBH notes the Applicant's response. Havering welcomes the proposed Requirement for Grove Farm as set out in the Schedule of ExA's recommended amendments to the Applicant's draft DCO Version 6 [PD-021].
