London Borough of Havering (20025659) London Borough of Havering Response to Savills on behalf of Gardens of Peace Muslim Cemetery (REP9-080)

It was noted that Savills have restated the need for the Applicant to apply for planning approval for the temporary car park on land within the cemetery but outside of the DCO order limits.

As Havering stated in its Deadline 9 response (REP9-077), the Applicant has been in contact with Havering as the Local Planning Authority regarding this matter, however no formal Planning Application has been submitted to date. It is further noted from the Applicant's submission (REP9-069) that the Applicant is waiting for further information from Gardens of Peace before an application can be submitted.

Havering maintains its position as set out in REP7-033 that LB Havering is not in a position to give any indication of whether planning permission for such a facility would be granted when no application has been submitted to the Local Authority for scrutiny at this stage.
