Dear Sirs

I wish to speak at the Issue specific hearing on behalf of the British Horse Society on the following

1. Equestrian access across the A3 / M25 interchange
2. Address the issues surrounding the past and present exchange land
3. Address the issues surrounding the two-way multiuse track alongside the A3 to the new Access road to Wisley common.
 - a. Is this to be a right of way or part of the carriageway set aside for all non-motorised users eg a type of horse margin
 - b. Address the issue of modern high-powered cycle and cycle helmet lights moving against the road traffic flow.
4. Address the issues surrounding the equestrian access around the junction connecting the RoW/highway network and the common land and public open space lands and any exchange land
5. There is no requirement for SCC [request to SoCGs] to address the impact on the public's right to air and exercise and open recreation on the registered commons including s193 LPA 1925 and that land held under the Open Spaces Act 1910.
