## Proposed M25J10 / A3 interchange works - Document APP-046

We would like to put on record that we believe the flood vulnerability of Ockham cannot be underestimated in relation to the proposed works.

Storms Ciara and Dennis have both caused serious problems with rainwater pouring off Three Farms Meadow/Former Wisley Airfield and onto Elm Lane, Old Lane and the A3.

At a time of minimal traffic due to half term holidays (16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020) the A3 was reduced to one lane southbound creating maximum disruption. The delays tailed along the M25 and right up the A3 as far as the Esher/Oxshott interchange A244/A3 interchange.

Water offrun through Elm Corner flooded the road completely making it impossible for some residents to get out and Old Lane was almost impassable in some places.

We note that some mitigation for flooding has been planned within document APP-046 but seek further reassurance.
