## 1. Introduction

1.1.1 This document provides a plan in support of Highways England's response to ExA's Written Question 2.8.1, as detailed in TR010030/Volume 9.58, which is also submitted at Deadline 5.
1.1.2 The ExA's question 2.8.1 asked of the Applicant:
"In RHS Wisley's RR [RR-024] and in [REP4-049] reference is made to the possible loss of redwood trees close to the boundary due to tree root impact and this issue not yet being resolved. Please comment on the current situation in regard to your assessment of this as in [REP2-014, page 85] you refer to tree root surveys "still being analysed"."
1.1.3 The plan below shows the structural root zones of the relevant trees along the RHS boundary with the A3. This document should be read in conjunction with the Applicant's response to question 2.8.1.
1.1.4 The latest version of the draft Development Consent Order (TR010030/Volume 3.1 (2)), as submitted at Deadline 5, has been amended to include requirement 18 with reference to this drawing.
