### **M25 junction 10/A3 Wisley interchange scheme (the Scheme)**

**Highways England's Deadline 6 submission –3 April 2020**

Please find enclosed the submission of Highways England for Deadline 6. This submission consists of a number of enclosures and separate documents which are submitted in response to various requests made in the Examining Authority's (ExA) Rule 8 letter [PD-005] issued on 20 November 2019.

The Deadline 6 submission comprises the following documents in addition to this letter:

1. Highways England's comments on Interested Parties' responses to the ExA's Second Written Questions (**TR010030/Volume 9.78**), which includes a number of supporting documents as follows:

- Highways England's response to Ockham Parish Council's comments on climate change (raised in Ockham Parish Council's response to ExQ2 REP5-041) under document reference **TR0130030/Volume 9.76**.

2. In order to assist the Examining Authority, Highways England has provided responses to the following Deadline 5 submissions by interested parties:

- Response to Royal Horticultural Society's Deadline 5 submission (document reference **TR0130030/Volume 9.75**).
- Response to Environment Agency's Deadline 5 submission (document reference **TR0130030/Volume 9.77**).
- Response to Ronald Alderson's Deadline 5 submission (document reference **TR0130030/Volume 9.79**).

3. **Statutory Undertaker Representations with regard to section 127 Planning Act 2008 (Rev 2)**

Highways England has updated the schedule of statutory undertaker representations to which section 127 of the Planning Act 2008 applies. This was submitted initially at Deadline 2 as REP2-020. It was updated for Deadline 3 [REP3-005] and Deadline 5a [REP5a-009]. An update is provided at Deadline 6 under document reference number **TR0130030/Volume 9.25 (3)**.

#### **4. Statutory Undertaker Representations with regard to section 138 Planning Act 2008 (Rev 3)**

Highways England has provided a schedule of statutory undertaker representations to which section 138 of the Planning Act 2008 applies. This was submitted initially at Deadline 2 as REP2-021 and subsequently updated at Deadline 3 [REP3-006], Deadline 4 [REP4-002] and Deadline 5a [REP5a-010]. An update is provided at Deadline 6 under document reference number **TR0130030/Volume 9.26 (4)**.

#### **5. Statements of Common Ground**

At Deadline 6 a revised Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) with Wisley Property Investments Limited is provided under document reference **TR0130030/Volume 9.39 (1)**.

#### **6. Highways England's third revised dDCO**

An updated version of Highways England's draft Development Consent order is submitted under document reference **TR010030/Volume/3.1 (3)** (clean version) and **TR0130030/Volume/9.28 (2)** (tracked version).

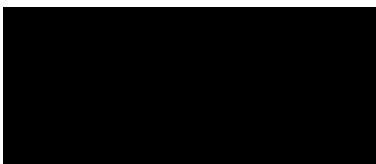
In addition, in order to assist the ExA and interested parties, Highways England has provided a summary of amendments to the draft development consent order (dDCO) as revised for Deadline 6 (**document reference TR0130030/Volume 9.80**) and updated the Explanatory Memorandum that explains the purpose and effect of the provisions in the latest version of the draft order (**document reference TR0130030/Volume 3.2 (1)** (clean) and **TR0130030/Volume 9.81** (tracked)). Highways England trusts that the provision of this document will assist all parties in the effective consideration of matters to be discussed going forward in the examination.

A revised Guide to the Application is submitted with document reference **TR010030/Volume 9.6 (7)**, and will continue to be submitted in revised form at each examination deadline in accordance with the request in the rule 6 letter.
