## REQUEST FOR COMMENTS FROM THE APPLICANT AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES

## 1. Request for comments from Interested Parties on the Applicant's response to the Secretary of State

The Secretary of State invites **Interested Parties** to provide any comments on the Applicant's response of 26 January 2022 to the Secretary of State's <u>consultation letter</u> of 22 <u>December 2021</u>. <u>The Applicant's response</u> consists of a number of documents which can be found on the Planning Inspectorate website; the Secretary of State draws particular attention to the <u>response letter</u> to the Secretary of State's request.

## 2. Request for clarification from the Applicant on its response to the Secretary of State

In <u>section 6.2</u> of the Applicant's response, it is stated that "the information provided in Table 2.2 of the Applicant's response of 9 August 2021 was derived from all road links in the traffic model provided for the air quality assessment". The Secretary of State invites **the Applicant** to define (or, where already provided, make reference to a definition of) the scope of "all road links in the traffic model provided for the air quality

assessment". The Secretary of State requests a map where the Applicant can appropriately provide one.

## The deadline for any response is 4 March 2022.
