

* Brief statement to explain why this application is, or is to be treated as, a development for which development consent is required under the Planning Act 2008

This application for development consent has been submitted by Highways England for the provision of alterations to the A1 between land north of junction 67 (Coal House) and junction 65 (Birtley) at Gateshead.

The Scheme is an NSIP within sections 14 (1) (h) and 22 (1) (b) of the Planning Act 2008. Under section 22, an NSIP must fall within one of three categories specified, which are expressly stated to be alternatives. This Scheme is an "alteration" within the meaning of section 22 (1) (b). The alteration consists of online widening of the A1 south of Gateshead to four lanes between junction 67 (Coal House) and junction 65 (Birtley) on the southbound carriageway and three lanes with lane gain/drop between junctions on the northbound carriageway to provide additional capacity. The Scheme will also include the off-line replacement of Allerdene Bridge immediately south of the existing structure to tie into the existing structure at junction 67 (Coal House).

The Scheme satisfies section 22 (3) (a) (b) and (c) in that all the highway involved is wholly in England, Highways England is the strategic highway authority for the highway, and the area of development is greater than the relevant limit set out in section 22 (4) (b). The relevant area for development under section 22 (4) (b) is 12.5 hectares because the highway being altered is a highway, other than a motorway, where the speed limit for any class of vehicle is expected to be 50 miles per hour or greater. The General Arrangement Plans (Application Document Reference: TR010031/APP/2.6) shows the area of development, namely "the land on which the part of the highway to be altered is situated and any adjoining land expected to be used in conjunction with its alteration". The area for development is 85.57 hectares, which thereby exceeds the hectare threshold.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development



* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Scheme comprises:

- The widening of the southbound carriageway from three to four lanes, and widening of the northbound carriageway from two to three lanes (with an additional lane between junctions) between junction 67 (Coal House) and junction 65 (Birtley);
- Changes to signage and road markings on the southbound carriageway between just south of junction 68 (Lobley Hill) and junction 67 (Coal House);
- The Scheme includes a replacement bridge structure where the A1 crosses over the East Coast Main Line (ECML), 40 metres to the immediate south of the existing Allerdene Bridge structure, which would tie into the existing carriageways at junction 67 (Coal House) and north of junction 66 (Eighton Lodge);
- Replacement of existing North Dene Footbridge located between junction 66 (Eighton Lodge) and junction 65 (Birtley) to accommodate the widening of the A1;
- Diversion of utilities.

A full description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2 of the Environment Statement (Application Document Reference: TR010031/APP/6.1).

6. Location or route of the Proposed Development

The proposed development is in the North East of England and is located in the Metropolitan Borough of Gateshead Council. The site is located on the A1 dual carriageway between land north of junction 67 (Coal House) and junction 65 (Birtley). This section of the A1 forms part of the Newcastle-Gateshead Western Bypass (NGWB) which extends between junction 80 (Seaton Burn) to junction 65 (Birtley). The location of the proposed development is shown on the Location Plan (Application Document Reference: TR010031/APP/2.1).
