#### CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC ASSESSMENT

1.1.1. **Figure 1-1** and **Table 1-1** below show the routes used to access the construction site and the additional flows generated during construction – split by Light and Heavy vehicles. None of the routes exceed the relevant (Design Manual for Roads and Bridges) DMRB criteria – i.e. 1,000 vehicles Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT), or 200 Heavy Duty Vehicle (HDVs), and are therefore screened out of further consideration for further assessment.
