

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#### 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1 The purpose of this document is to set out the locations the Applicant considers the Examining Authority ("ExA") may wish to visit as part of an Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI).
- 1.1.2 This version of the document (Revision 1) has been amended to incorporate the changes suggested by the ExA to the Applicant in an email on 3 March 2020.



#### 2 ITINERARY

- 2.1.1 The proposed itinerary for the ASI is provided in **Table 2.1** below and will take place on Tuesday 31 March 2020 between 09:30 and 16:00.
- 2.1.2 The itinerary presented in **Table 2.1** below is supported by a plan showing the proposed route, contained in **Appendix A** of this document. In addition to showing the proposed stopping locations, the plan also shows points of interest; these will be pointed out during the course of the ASI at the appropriate times.
- 2.1.3 The Applicant will bring relevant plans submitted as part of the Development Consent Order application.
- 2.1.4 The ASI will involve the use of a minibus (to be provided by the Applicant to accommodate the attendees of the site visit) but will include some walking. The Applicant will provide hi-vis jackets / vests and everyone attending will be required to use these. Please ensure that safety boots or appropriate footwear are worn as the inspection will include some walking on uneven or wet ground, and clothing suitable to the weather conditions is worn.
- 2.1.5 All attendees should bring their own lunch and refreshments as these are not able to be provided by the Applicant. Toilet facilities are available at the Newcastle Gateshead Marriott Hotel and at the comfort break stop at Sainsbury's, Team Valley Trading Estate.
- 2.1.6 The site visit will be mainly within publicly accessible land. There is one land parcel on private land (plot 3/6c of the Land Plans [AS-002]) belonging to Northern Gas Networks Limited (NGN) and site access is being arranged with the permission of the landowner.
- 2.1.7 **Table 2.1** below has a full list of relevant locations for the Scheme. However, those locations marked with an Asterix (\*) could be removed if there are time restrictions.
- 2.1.8 Please note that the Examining Authority will visit the Vigo railway bridge, as suggested by the Tyne and Wear Joint Local Access Forum, on an unaccompanied basis.
