Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A1 Birtley to Coal House Improvement Scheme

Revised Examination Timetable and request for representations from **Interested Parties on potential Hearing arrangements**

As confirmed in my letter of 24 March 2020, the Hearings that had been previously scheduled from 31 March to 3 April 2020 had to be postponed in the light of the current public health situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. In that letter I also revised the Examination Timetable to include an additional round of Written Ouestions (published on 6 April 2020), including several matters that I had intended to raise at the Hearings. I thank the parties for responding to these questions.

I am now considering how to proceed with the Examination and how best to ensure fairness in the current circumstances given the practical constraints that we all currently face. The Examination is primarily a written process and that process will continue.

However, there is still an obligation to hold both an Open Floor Hearing and a Compulsory Acquisition Hearing following previous requests to be heard at such Hearings by Interested Parties. Furthermore, whilst several issues appear capable of examination in writing, it may be necessary to hold further Issue Specific Hearing(s) in order for oral representations to be made to ensure that there is adequate examination of a particular issue or issues.

The Examination is scheduled to be completed by 21 July 2020 and it remains possible that Hearings will be able to take place by this date, albeit with revisions to the current timetable. However, in the current circumstances, there is a need for special arrangements and preparations for such Hearings.



I am considering holding the Hearings required during the remainder of the Examination remotely, using teleconferencing and/or video conferencing facilities. Teleconferencing typically involves the use of a telephone, mobile telephone, or a smartphone, tablet or computer connected to the internet to hold an audio discussion between participants and the Examining Authority (ExA). Video conferencing typically involves the use of a smartphone, tablet or computer connected to the internet to hold an audio discussion between participants and the Examining Authority (ExA). I have consequently revised the Examination Timetable (**Annex A**). It includes an opportunity for representations to be made on future Hearing arrangements and a series of revised dates for any future Hearings to take place.

I am now requesting representations on future Hearings, including your wish and/or ability to take part in Hearings using teleconferencing and/or video conferencing.

Please note that the Hearings scheduled in the previous timetable for the 9, 10 and 11 June 2020 will not be taking place. As set out in the revised timetable, Hearings are now scheduled for w/c 22 June 2020 with further provision made for Hearings during w/c 29 June and on 13 July and 14 July should these be required. It is not anticipated that all these dates will be needed but they are included at this stage for flexibility. Later on I will set out detailed arrangements and procedures for the Hearings.

Written Questions



Given that I have recently asked an additional round of Written Questions on 6 April 2020 and taking account of the revisions I have made to the Examination Timetable, I have no further Written Questions at this time. However, you will note that I have added an opportunity for a further round of Written Questions within the revised timetable.

Application Changes

As set out in my previous letter of **6 May 2020** I have made a Procedural Decision to accept the Applicant's proposed changes to the application. I have consequently added an opportunity for written submissions to be made on these changes at **Deadline 7 on Tuesday 2 June 2020.** Any additional timetable variations required as a result of the relevant Compulsory Acquisition Regulations and procedures will be made in due course.

Lastly, I thank all Interested Parties for your continued participation in the Examination, particularly during the difficult current circumstances that we are all experiencing.
