NWL has today signed a Statement of Common Ground with Highways England which includes the agreed Protective Provisions for inclusion in the Order. NWL understands that the Applicant will submit the SOCG and a revised version of the Order today. Although NWL has not seen the latest version of the draft Order, we assume that the paragraph numbering properly reflects the position of the Protective Provisions in the relevant part of Schedule 11.

NWL has reviewed the Applicant's Deadline 11 submissions and notes that in 'The Applicant's Response to Deadline 9 and 10 Submissions', the Applicant has commented "The Applicant does not accept that NWL has a compensatable interest in land, but it is open to NWL to seek compensation.". NWL's position is set out in the SOCG at table 3.1.
