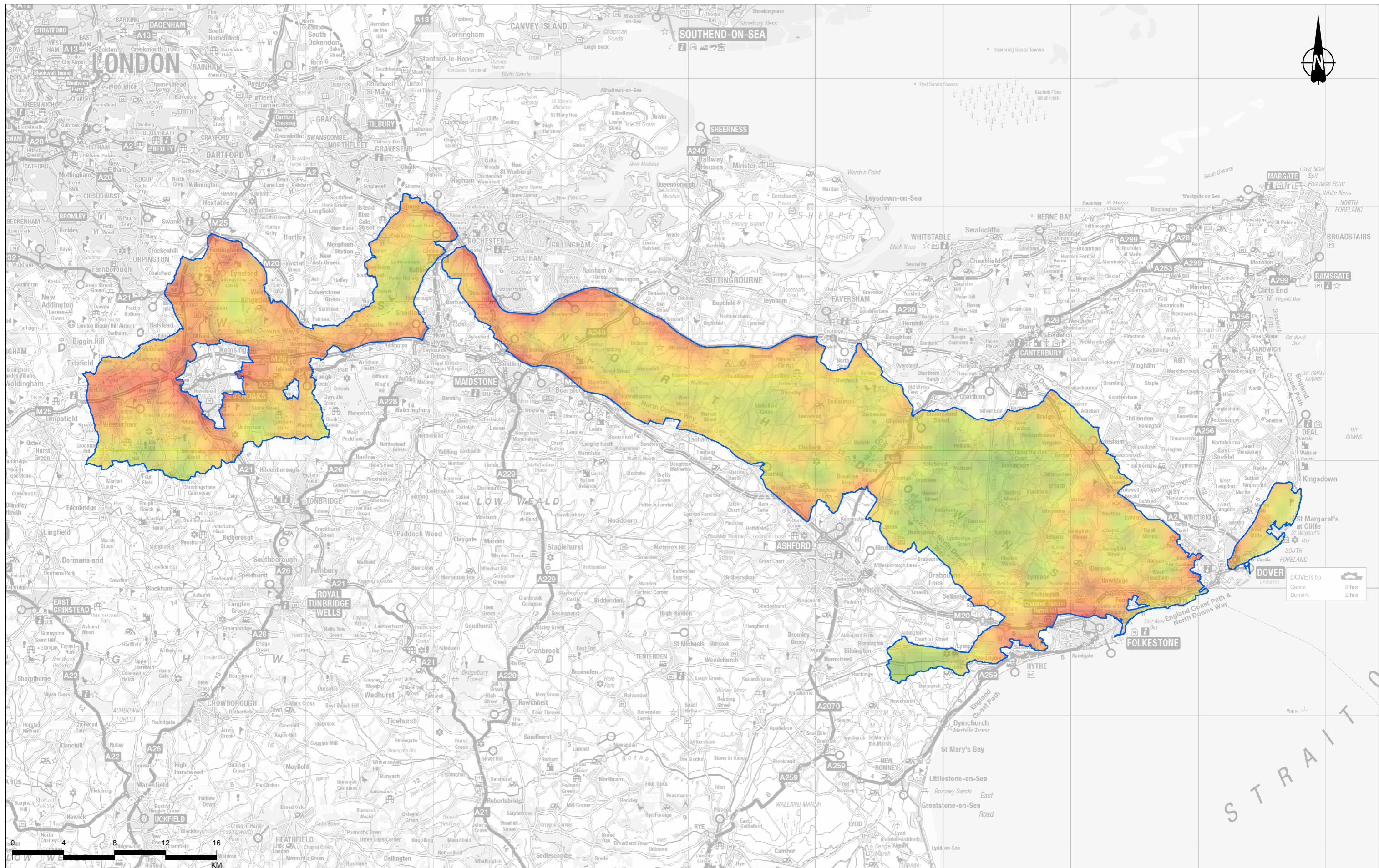
Figure 7.21.3 - Existing Tranquillity within Kent Downs AONB

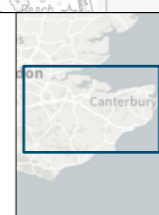
