Duty to consult-Planning Act 2008 -S42

Basildon Borough Council considers that Highways England have consulted with all the persons, organisations and Local Authorities, required by S42 of the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008), as set out in Appendix H of the Consultation Report.

The applicant had engaged with Basildon Borough Council as a Local Authority that which meets the criteria set out in Section 47 of the Planning Act 2008.
