This will include a plan of the location to be inspected and a briefing in relation to the health and safety requirements in force at what is an operational tunnelling project. be subject to change at the discretion of the ExA, responding to matters such as guidance by the HS2 Ltd (the tunnelling undertaker), weather or traffic conditions.

At the request of the tunnelling undertaker, attendance at this ASI is to be limited to the ExA, Planning Inspectorate Case Team staff in support of the ExA, representatives of the Applicant and representatives of the local planning authorities whose areas are affected by the Lower Thames Crossing tunnelling proposals: Thurrock and Gravesham Councils. The Thames Crossing Action Group (TCAG) may also nominate a representative to attend if they wish. As the consent of the tunnelling undertaker is required to take any persons onto operational land, it should be noted that it will not be possible to accommodate any further requests to attend this site inspection.

The Applicant, Thurrock and Gravesham Councils and TCAG are requested to inform the Case Team of the names of the attendees no later than Deadline 5, 3 October 2023, by email to the project mailbox marked 'ASI4 – Chiltern Tunnel'. Please draw the ExA's attention to any particular needs or requests that IPs may have relating to their participation. Alternatively, they can email or write to the Case Team using the contact details at the head of this letter to confirm your participation. Please address any letter to the 'Lower Thames Crossing Case Team', include the case reference TR010032/ 'ASI4 – Chiltern Tunnel' and a contact telephone number. Postal communications must be posted in good time to be received by the Planning Inspectorate by Deadline 5.

Intending attendees should note that there will be no catering provided at these events. It is the responsibility of individual attendees to bring their own refreshments. It cannot be assumed that refreshments will be available for purchase within the tunnelling compound.
