1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on behalf of the Secretary of State in relation to an application made by National Highways (the Applicant) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008.
- 1.1.2 The application is for the grant of development consent for the A122 Lower Thames Crossing. Should development consent be granted, the draft A122 (Lower Thames Crossing) Development Consent Order (Application Document 3.1) (the draft Order) will be made by the Secretary of State (subject to any modifications considered appropriate).
- 1.1.3 Two cross sections have been requested by representatives of The Whitecroft Care Home in the Kathryn Homes Ltd, Runwood Homes Ltd and Runwood Properties Ltd, Deadline 1 Submission Written Representation (WR) [REP1-373]. These were provided to the representatives of Whitecroft Care home on the 14th September. Following the ASI on the 14th September these have since been provided in line with Action 3C as described in document 9.111 Actions from Accompanied Site Visit [Document Reference [9.111]]. The requested cross sections, which have been provided by the Applicant as part of this document, are listed in Table 1.1 below.

Table 1.1 Cross sections at the Whitecroft Care Home


Cross section reference	Description
The Whitecroft Care Home Section A	An east-west cross section during construction between the grounds of The Whitecroft Care Home and Heath Road. The construction section illustrates the approximate location of the construction access route (haul route) and the permanent landscape mound proposed to the west of the property. (A cross section during operation has also been provided for context.)
The Whitecroft Care Home Section B	A north-south cross section during operation between The Whitecroft Care Home and the proposed Lower Thames Crossing route to the south and the Lower Thames crossing to A13 eastbound slip road to the north.


- 1.1.4 The construction access route (haul route) shown in The Whitecroft Care Home Section A corresponds to the offline routes necessary for construction access (refer to Deadline 3 Submission Other: 2.17 Temporary Works Plans Volume C (sheets 21 to 49) v3.0 clean [REP3-071] for illustrative routes) and is shown within the approximate area where the proposed works are taking place. This route is illustrative and a snapshot in time during the works. The proposed works shown on the Temporary Works Plans will be subject to change as part of detailed design development and establishment of the construction methodology. Any changes will be subject to the constraints included in, o secured by, the Development Consent Order [REP3-077].
- 1.1.5 The cross sections during operation show the vertical Limits of Deviation of 0.5m upward and 1m downward, as set out in article 6(2) of the draft Development Consent Order [REP3-077].

- 1.1.6 The cross section during construction shown on Section A includes indicative information on:
 - a. Approximate location of the proposed construction access route (haul route)
 - b. Outline of a proposed cutting slope
 - c. Outline of a proposed permanent landscape mound
- 1.1.7 The cross sections during operation on Section A and Section B include indicative information on:
 - a. Vegetation removal
 - b. Proposed planting
 - c. Gantries
 - d. Lighting columns
 - e. Vehicles
- 1.1.8 A full cross section is shown at the top of each drawing, with large scale insets beneath to show key areas in more detail. The Whitecroft Care Home Section A shows one inset during construction and one inset during operation. The Whitecroft Care Home Section B shows two insets during operation.
- 1.1.9 These cross sections are designed to be viewed on a screen and are shown at various scales which do not match those prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009. The scales were chosen to suit the type of information displayed and so that interested parties can see the extents of the cross sections more easily on one drawing sheet, rather than spread over multiple sheets.
