

### 1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 This document is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on behalf of the Secretary of State in relation to an application made by National Highways (the Applicant) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008.
- 1.1.2 The application is for the grant of development consent for the A122 Lower Thames Crossing. Should development consent be granted, the draft A122 (Lower Thames Crossing) Development Consent Order (Application Document 3.1) (the draft Order) will be made by the Secretary of State (subject to any modifications considered appropriate).
- 1.1.3 Further illustrative material in relation to Kent Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the proposed Utilities works was requested by the Examining Authority (ExA) during Issue Specific Hearing 9, as addressed in document 9.132 Post-event submissions, including written submission of oral comments, for ISH9. The proposed utilities works are as shown in the Works Plans (REP4-038 and REP5-020).
- 1.1.4 This drawing is designed to be viewed on a screen and is shown at a scale that does not match those prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009. The scale was chosen to suit the type of information displayed and so that interested parties can see the extents of the works more easily on one drawing sheet, rather than spread over multiple sheets.
