1 Introduction


- 1.1.1 This document has been prepared in response to Action 6 from Issue Specific Hearing 9 requesting a plan overlaying the extent of ancient woodland proposed to be removed onto the proposed utility works, as offered by the Applicant in 9.132 Post-event submissions, including written submission of oral comments, for ISH9 [REP6-090].
- 1.1.2 These plans are designed to be viewed on a screen and are shown at a nonstandard scale (approximately 1:4000) which does not match those prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009. This scale was chosen as it is better suited to the type of information displayed and so that interested parties can see the extents of the scheme more easily on one sheet, rather than across multiple sheets.
- 1.1.3 These plans show the same information and design as shown within the 2.6 Works Plans [REP4-040] and REP5-018] and in the Figure 2.4 Environmental Masterplan [REP4-124, REP3-100] and REP4-129]. It should be noted that the utility working areas shown are only the ones that impact Ancient Woodland and do not represent the entirety of the Project and its proposed utility working areas.




