The Council has reviewed the responses given by the Applicant to the second set of Written Questions from the ExA (ExQ2), and would like to offer the following comments.

9.153 Responses to the Examining Authority's ExQ2 Appendix D – 6,7,8 [REP6-110]

ExQ2_Q8.1.3: Transportation of materials and waste

The Council welcomes the commitment from the Applicant to maximising use of river transport, which would help to reduce the number of heavy goods vehicles on the Strategic Road Network and help reduce the impact of construction traffic.

ExQ2_Q8.1.4: Excavated materials

The Council welcomes the clarification that no significant increase in excavated materials is expected as deviation is constrained and most arisings from tunnelling is based on diameter.

ExQ2_Q8.1.5: Waste hierarchy

LB Havering welcomes the change of wording to MW007 and will be indicating this in a separate submission to the ExA responding to the Applicant's submitted Deadline 6 Submissions. The response provided by the Applicant to Q8.1.5 is considered reasonable.
