London Borough of Havering (20035775) – Update on Section 106 Agreement

Dear Sir,

At Deadline 8 LB Havering provided the ExA with a position statement on progress in reaching an agreed Section 106 with the Applicant (REP8-148). LB Havering can now report to the ExA that the “*very minor outstanding drafting points*” that were not resolved at Deadline 8 have now been dealt with satisfactorily.

LB Havering can report that a Section 106 has now been fully agreed with the Applicant.

The Applicant will be sending engrossments to Havering for signing, and sealing.

Whilst it is hoped that this process can be completed before the end of the Examination, due to Havering’s internal governance arrangements that is not considered likely.

Should submitting a signed Section 106 agreement to the ExA before the end of the Examination prove not possible, Havering intends to submit a signed copy of the Section 106 agreement to the Lower Thames Crossing Case Team, post the conclusion of the Examination. It is anticipated that such a scenario would result in the signed Section 106 being submitted to PINS in January.
