We would like to make ExA aware that we have still not received any verbal or written communication from the applicant, in regards to our questions, queries and concerns about the proposed project. We feel that this is vital, for us to progress and move forward with our very stressful situation.

We would like to bring to the attention of ExA that we are concerned that the diagrams presented by the applicant for the proposed green bridges for bat mitigation {6.3 Environmental Statement Appendices, Appendix 8.16 part 4.4} REP-056 are inadequate.

When scrolling through the images we noticed that the Thong Lane green bridge diagram is showing footpaths, cycling and bridleway in detail, where as all the other green bridge diagrams are not showing any footpaths cycling or bridleways. Does this mean there are none?

We know that the North Road green bridge is supposed to have them, due to our property being in close proximity. We recognise that these diagram images are to show bat mitigation but we find the information confusing, unclear and misleading. They seem to be generic and it does not show a true reflection of the proposed green bridges especially the North Road green bridge. Surely at this late stage one would expect these designs to be accurate if we are to give the local wildlife the mitigation it deserves.
