On pg 31 National Highways states:

My reply:

I would be very interested to hear precisely how National Highways considers it has “continued engagement with Mr T Thacker outside of the examination process”.

There has been absolutely no dialogue of any kind between myself National Highways for several years.

The last dialogue between myself and National Highways was an email I received on 28th August 2020. This email was the conclusion of a dialogue that was initiated by me to rectify the fiasco of the numerous letters sent to my family stating incorrectly that our property “is within or partially within the development boundary or potentially affected by the proposals”.

I would therefore be very interested to hear what engagement National Highways believes it has had with me outside of the examination process. I would kindly request a list of dates, formats and context of this “engagement”. Should National Highways not be able to provide proof of this engagement then a retraction and correction of the above statement would of course be in order.
