### **Deadline 10 Submission**

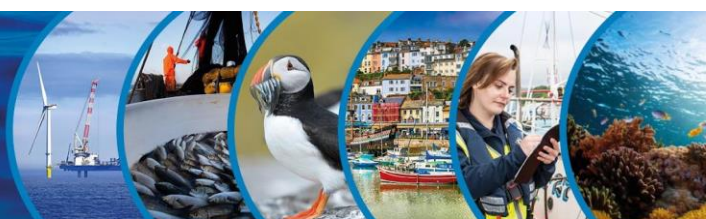

The MMO has finalised the review of the information submitted at Deadline 9. The MMO have no further comments to make at this Deadline.



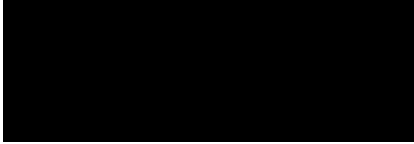
