thank you for your invitation to comment.

I have objected each time invited and at every stage of this programme, citing destruction of the environment of both human and animals alike.

Concreting huge swathes of our tiny island is as reckless as it is destructive, encouraging the release of massive volumes carbon dioxide from cement manufacture (6% of global CO2 emissions) and a myriad other industry processes better reserved for repairing crumbling infrastructure.
