1 Update following the Chancellor of the Exchequer's speech

- 1.1 We are writing following the <u>speech</u> made by the Chancellor of Exchequer on 29 January 2025. In the <u>publication</u> accompanying the speech, the Chancellor set out:
 - "The government is also assessing options for privately financing the Lower Thames Crossing, which will improve connectivity across vital ports and alleviate congestion as goods to be exported come from across the country to markets overseas"
- 1.2 The Applicant considers it would be helpful to provide the Secretary of State with an update on the effect of this announcement on the Lower Thames Crossing DCO application. The Applicant would, if the Secretary of State agrees, propose as part of this update to include a revised Funding Statement. Noting that the government is assessing options, the updated Funding Statement would supplement the existing publicly funded option with privately financed options that the Applicant considers to be viable.
- 1.3 The Applicant would, subject to the Secretary of State's agreement, propose to provide this information no later than 27 February 2025. We expect and understand the Secretary of State will, in turn, wish to allow a period of time for interested parties to comment on submissions made. We would welcome an opportunity to provide a further response to those submissions prior to the Secretary of State's decision on the DCO application.
- 1.4 We would welcome your position on this proposal, and the 27 February 2025 deadline proposed. The Applicant will endeavour to comply with any deadlines established by the Secretary of State.
