1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 This Guide to the Documents to be Certified (this 'Guide') is provided in relation to the A57 Link Road Scheme (the 'Scheme'). Highways England (the 'Applicant') has submitted an application under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the 'PA 2008') for an Order to grant Development Consent Order (a DCO) for the Scheme.
- 1.1.2 The purpose of this Guide is to help the Examining Authority and interested parties understand the draft DCO through identifying the latest version of any document that it is to certify. It also aims to help the Examining Authority and interested parties understand the parameters for implementing the DCO and how it will be implemented.
- 1.1.3 This Guide has been submitted with the application and will be updated where necessary throughout the Examination to confirm:
- any revised versions of any application documents; and/or
 - any additional documents produced since submission of the application that would be certified documents were the Secretary of State to grant development consent based on the DCO as drafted at the point of issue of this Guide.
- 1.1.4 The documents identified in Table 1 replicate those listed in Schedule 10, 'Documents to be Certified' in the draft DCO [TR010054/APP/3.1].

1.2 Guide to the Documents to be Certified

- 1.2.1 Table 1 below sets out the Documents to be Certified by the Secretary of State.
- 1.2.2 The table tracks the latest version of the documents, with previous superseded versions to be greyed out. The Table is to be reviewed and treated as a "document" during the Examination process.
- 1.2.3 It will also record any new documents submitted at particular Examination Deadlines.
