1. Introduction

1.1 Introduction and purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 Highways England (the "Applicant") has applied to the Secretary of State for Development Consent Order ("DCO") to determine the Applicant's proposals for the creation of new link roads and alteration to the existing A57, A57 Link Roads (the "Scheme"). The application is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") in accordance with section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act").
- 1.1.2 This document comprises part of the suite of Application documents and is submitted to comply with Regulation 5(2)(o), of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (as amended), which requires:

5(2)(o) 'any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is sought, showing details of design, external appearance, and the preferred layout of buildings and structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping;'


1.2 Scope and format of the Location Plan

- 1.2.1 The purpose of the Location plan is to identify the location of the Scheme in its wider geographical context.
- 1.2.2 Although Regulation 5(2)(o) does not expressly stipulate that a location plan must be provided, appendix one of the Planning Inspectorate's Advice Note Six: Preparation and submission of application documents (November 2019: version 8) suggests that a location plan may be included in the submission of a DCO application.
- 1.2.3 As a consequence, this plan uses a smaller scale than that prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 but only so that the wider geographical context can be represented on a single sheet plan.
- 1.2.4 This document should be read alongside and is informed by the other Application documents, in particular:
 - Draft Development Consent Order [TR010034/APP/3.1]; and
 - Case for the Scheme [TR010034/APP/7.1]
