### 1. Introduction

### 1.1 Introduction and purpose of this document

- 1.1.1 Highways England (the "Applicant") has applied to the Secretary of State for Development Consent Order ("DCO") to determine the Applicant's proposals for the creation of new link roads and alteration to the existing A57, A57 Link Roads (the "Scheme"). The application is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") in accordance with section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act").
- 1.1.2 This document comprises part of the suite of Application documents and is submitted to comply with Regulation 5(2)(i), of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (as amended), which requires:

'5(2)(i) 'a land plan identifying-

- (i) the land required for, or affected by, the proposed development;
- (ii) where applicable, any land over which it is proposed to exercise powers of compulsory acquisition or any right to use land;
- (iii) any land in relation to which it is proposed to extinguish easements, servitudes and other private rights; and
- (iv) where the land includes special category land and replacement land, that special category and replacement land.'
- 1.1.3 This document specifically identifies open space within the DCO boundary, which is considered to be special category land. Other elements of regulation 5(2)(i) are indicated on the Land Plans [TR010034/APP/2.2].
- 1.1.4 Part of the land required for, or affected by the Scheme, comprises land that is special category land, notably registered common land or open space. As the DCO contains a range of different rights and powers over these two types of special category land, as well as making provision for suitable replacement land to be provided, the Special Category Land Plans are submitted as part of the Application, to provide greater clarity. This document should therefore be read alongside the Land Plans [TR010034/APP/2.2].

## 1.2 Scope and format of the Special Category Land Plans

1.2.1 The purpose of the Special Category Land Plans is to identify any land that is special category land, notably registered common land or open space. The Special Category Land Plans have been prepared having regard to the 'Planning Act 2008 Guidance related to procedures for the compulsory acquisition of land' published by the Department for Communities and Local Government in September 2013 and to advice provided by the Planning Inspectorate under Section 51 of the Planning Act 2008.






- 1.2.3 For ease of reference, the scale and layout of these plans align with the land plans and works plans. Only the sheet that indicating the Special Category Land is included in this document.





