OBJECTIONS: 1. Bypasses the village of Mottram but no relief for congestion in Hollingworth, Tintwistle, Glossop and the Peak National Park. Big new roads attract traffic, but, having passed Mottram, traffic from Manchester way will face a choice of the A628 or the Glossop Spur going via the A57 through Glossop and the Peak Park if heading for Sheffield.

2. Glossop is severely congested and becoming more so with the advent of new housing. The A57 through the Peak is hardly suitable for more traffic.

3. Careful consideration should be given to the alternatives e.g. (i) traffic regulation to oblige H.V.'s to use the M62 including rail and bus services to reduce car usage and improve the environment.

(ii) improved public transport including rail and bus services to reduce car usage and improve the environment.

4. Spending millions (iii) invest in rail goods transport pushes the problem a few hundred yards down the road. It would be better spent on alternatives to reduce road traffic.
