

Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A57 Link Roads

The Examining Authority's (ExA's) Record of its Second Unaccompanied Site Inspection

The ExA undertook its Second Unaccompanied Site Inspection over three days from 12 to 14 January 2022 by car and on foot, on public roads and public rights of way. The routes were planned having regard to the Applicant's Environmental Statement (ES) and enabled the ExA to obtain views of the application site and surrounding area.
