

^{4. &}quot;Thank you for your email received by the Highways England contact centre on 5 November 2020 about the exclusion of the village of Padfield from the A57 Link Roads project consultation mailing zone.

We've considered the request to extend our consultation mailing zone to include the area of Padfield, however we feel that the large zone which we have already distributed consultation packs to adequately covers the communities most affected by the scheme.

To raise awareness of the consultation within the wider communities, we've placed notices in local newspapers, we'll be displaying posters and large adverts around the area, and we're using existing Local Authority channels to inform a wider audience. Padfield is also one of the many areas included within our target zone for social media advertising, meaning any Facebook user living within the area will see notifications about our consultation.

All our materials are stored online, and copies are available in three deposit points. The closest deposit point to Padfield is the newsagents on New Road, Tintwistle or Hollingworth post office. We're also offering hard copies of the consultation brochure and response form on request, as well as all our other materials on a DVD or USB.

Further to our telephone conversation I can confirm that I have placed a poster about the scheme on the community notice board and I am looking to arrange for the consultation vehicle to be parked in the area over the next two weeks, I would be grateful if you could confirm the access rights to the area adjacent to the railway bridge on Platt street as discussed.
