A585 WINDY HARBOUR TO SKIPPOOL IMPROVEMENT SCHEME ("SCHEME")
APPLICATION FOR A DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER ("ORDER")

The Duchy of Lancaster has a freehold interest in the mines and minerals in various plots of land proposed to be subject to compulsory acquisition or temporary possession pursuant to the Order. Such land is accordingly Crown land for the purposes of the Planning Act 2008 ("the 2008 Act").

As you will be aware, section 135 of the 2008 Act states that a Development Consent Order may only authorise the compulsory acquisition of an interest in Crown land if it is an interest which is for the time being held by someone other than the Crown and the appropriate Crown authority consents to the acquisition. The 2008 Act further provides that a Development Consent Order may only include any other provision in relation to Crown land or rights benefiting the Crown with the consent of the appropriate Crown authority.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Planning Inspectorate that, in accordance with section 277(5)(d), the Chancellor of the Duchy of Lancaster consents, for the purposes of sections 135(1) and 135(2) of the 2008 Act, to the acquisition, temporary possession and/or use of the Crown land and rights as proposed in the application for the Order.
