## A585 Windy Harbour to Skippool Improvement Scheme ("the Scheme")

I refer to our previous correspondence in connection with the above matter.

As you are aware, Highways England needs to acquire the following plots of land, which our records show you have an interest, in order to implement the Scheme. These include plots 1/05 and 1/05a.

Following further engagement with various statutory bodies, Highways England has been requested to make changes to the Scheme, including construction of a dwarf wall and widening of the northern footway/cycleway from Skippool Road. The dwarf wall will provide flood protection and the widening of the footway/cycleway will accommodate the diversion of utilities. The proposed changes are shown on the enclosed drawing (HE548643-ARC-LLO-SZ\_ZZ000DR-D-3017).

You will see that, in order to carry out the changes, Highways England will need to vary the extent of the land you are shown to have an interest in, namely:
