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1 Introduction

1.1 Purpose of document

- 1.1.1 This document relates to an application made by Highways England (“the Applicant”) to the Planning Inspectorate under Section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (“the Application”).
- 1.1.2 This document contains copies of the newspaper notices that publicised the proposed application, the consultation Public Information Points and the process for making comments, in accordance with the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008).
- 1.1.3 Chapter 4 of the Consultation Report, (DCO document 5.1) provides further details on the notices.

2 Background to the newspaper notices

2.1.1 Section 48 of PA 2008 requires the Applicant to publicise the proposed Application in the prescribed manner. Regulation 4 of the APFP Regulation sets out this prescribed manner.

2.1.2 In accordance with Regulation 4 (2) of the APFP Regulations, the Applicant must publish a notice of the proposed Application ("the Section 48 Notice"). Bearing in mind the location of the scheme relating to this Application, the required publications were:

- Once in the London Gazette;
- Once in a national newspaper;
- For at least 2 consecutive weeks in 1 or more local newspapers circulating the vicinity in which the proposed development would be situated.

2.1.3 The notice contained certain information as prescribed in the Regulation 4 (3) of the APFP Regulations.

2.1.4 Section 47 of the PA 2008 requires the Applicant to prepare a statement setting out how the Applicant proposes to consult people living in the vicinity of the Scheme about the proposed Application, and then to publish this statement. This statement is known as the Statement of Community Consultation ("the SOCC").

2.1.5 In accordance with the APFP regulations, a notice was published in the public notice section of a national newspaper and in a local newspaper for 2 consecutive weeks. Highways England published the notice nationally in The Times and The London Gazette and locally in Somerset County Gazette and Western Daily Press.

2.1.6 Highways England undertook section 48 consultation during the same period as sections 42 and 47, for a period of 43 days from Friday 26 January to Friday 9 March 2018.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Weston-super-Mare Council to carry out a connection to facilitate gas mains replacement works. This will become operative on the 12th March 2018 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 12 days in duration.
