Please may I answer the question as follows

After meeting Mott MacDonald on the 16th January I believe that the elevated section of the A303 north of the Hazelgrove junction should have an acoustic barrier mounted on the south side of the road, extending west and eastwards in order to protect the community from the unreasonably high noise from the road. This barrier should be positioned at the edge of the road and be designed to reflect/absorb (hold the noise) onto the road.

A number of products are available including the Jakoustic Commercial and Highway Acoustic Fencing. The spec. data sheet indicates up to a 28dB noise reduction. The product meets Highway Agency standards and is promoted as being ideal for application in exposed locations subject to high winds loads
