I am writing regarding the A11/A47 Thickthorn Junction (the "Scheme"). This comprises the creation of one new connector road between the A11 and A47 with the aim of rerouting traffic away from the existing Thickthorn Junction, relieving congestion, improving the environment, and improving journey times. In addition, a new Cantley Lane Footbridge (Cringleford) will be provided across the A47 and a new link road will be located between Cantley Lane South and the B1172 Norwich Road, maintaining access to Thickthorn Junction. The Scheme aims to relieve congestion, reduce journey times, encourage economic growth, improve road safety and our customers' experience.

Highways England is seeking development consent for the Scheme under the Planning Act 2008 (PA 2008). This legislation requires Highways England to make an application to the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") for a Development Consent Order (DCO) to get the consent we need to build the Scheme.

Highways England submitted its application for a DCO on 31 March 2021. This application was accepted for examination by the Inspectorate (on behalf of the Secretary of State) on 28 April 2021. Highways England is writing to you because it is required to notify you of an accepted application.

In accordance with the PA 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017, please see attached to this email, a copy of:

- The section 56 notice, providing formal notification of acceptance of the application
- A map showing where the proposed development is to be sited

The Application form and the accompanying documents, plans and Environmental Statement can be viewed and downloaded free of charge online on the A11/A47 Thickthorn project page of the [Planning Inspectorate's National Infrastructure Planning website](#) (*under the documents tab*). An electronic copy of the application documents can be supplied free of charge on a USB memory stick.

Further information regarding the availability of the DCO Application documents and where you can view them is included in the enclosed section 56 notice.

Any person may make representations on the Application to the Secretary of State (that is: giving notice of any interest in or objection to the Application). Details of the way in

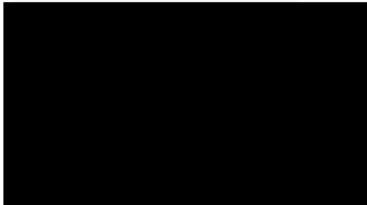
which representations must be made are included in the enclosed section 56 notice.

Representations can be made from Thursday 27 May 2021 and must be received by the Inspectorate no later than 11:59pm on Wednesday 7 July 2021. Please note that any submitted representations to the Inspectorate will be published on the National Infrastructure Planning website for the Application.
