DEADLINE 3 SUBMISSION: COMMENTS ON DRAFT DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER REV 2

We have reviewed the dDCO submitted by the Applicant at Deadline 2 [REP2-003] (Tracked), and wish to make the following comments:

Requirement 4 Environmental Management Plan

We note that, as previously requested, the Environment Agency is now included as a named consultee for this Requirement; specifically in respect of the Second Iteration EMP. Therefore we can confirm that this issue is now resolved.

Requirement 6 Contaminated land and groundwater

We previously highlighted that the determination of the need for remediation should be based on a consideration of the risk assessment by all parties, rather than determined solely by the undertaker. Also it should be stated that any necessary remedial measures will prevent any impacts on controlled waters. We requested that this Requirement be amended to reflect those points.

We note the amendments proposed by the Applicant for part (2) of R6. Given that we will have the opportunity to review and comment on the risk assessment under part (1) of R6, we can confirm that we are satisfied with the amended wording and that our previously raised issues with this Requirement are resolved.

Requirement 8 Surface water drainage

We note and welcome the addition of the Environment Agency as a named consultee in respect of part (1) of R8. However, we would request that the Environment Agency are also added as a named consultee for part (2). This will ensure that we are able to review any required amendments to the previously approved details.
