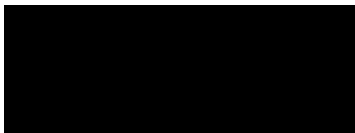
Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 outlines that the applicant must consult each local authority that is within Section 43. Suffolk County Council have been consulted at the required stages.
