It is currently an 'intrinsically dark' rural environment and whatever lighting is provided should be the absolute minimum and should be at pains to avoid any 'sky glow'. The Applicant should also take account of the research that suggests that LED streetlights are decimating moth numbers in England and advocates the use of bat friendly red lighting. See link below:
