Section 7. Draft Development Consent Order (DCO)

Q7.3.1 to Environment Agency

Requirement 6 of the dDCO [REP5-005] addresses contaminated land and groundwater. Is the EA satisfied that the wording of this Requirement provides adequate protection and would ensure the delivery of necessary mitigation, if required? If not, please explain why and what changes should be made to the Requirement.
