As a relevant Flood Risk Authority, the Board would like to be added as a consultee for the details of the surface and foul water drainage system.

The Board would also like to correct the following errors:

Consent is required from the Board for the introduction of any water and any increase in flow or volume of water to **any ordinary watercourse within the Internal Drainage District** as well as for any works which may temporarily or permanently affect the flow in any ordinary watercourse within the Internal Drainage District and for any works within 9 metres of any ordinary watercourses or drainage infrastructure vested in/under the control of the Board (the Board publishes its Board maintained / arterial watercourses on its website).
