- the scheme will be constructed slightly to the north of the existing A47 from the A1/A47 interchange for approximately 800m, before crossing the existing A47, where it will be constructed to the south of the existing alignment until it ties into the existing dual-carriageway at the Nene Way Roundabout.
- the scheme includes a new free flow slip road connecting the existing A1 southbound carriageway to the new A47 eastbound carriageway. The existing diverge lane off the A1 southbound is retained as part of these arrangements to connect to the western roundabout at the A1/A47 junction for all other movements.
- the scheme includes improvements to the existing roundabouts at the A1/A47 junction and the existing Nene Way Roundabout to the eastern end of the scheme. The side roads along the route and access to local businesses will also be altered to improve their safety and reliability of the A47.
- the application will seek rights and powers required to deliver the scheme. This may include compulsory acquisition powers.

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
