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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose of this Document

- 1.1.1 This Location Plan (this "Plan") relates to an application made by Highways England (the "Applicant") to the Secretary of State for Transport, via the Planning Inspectorate (the "Inspectorate") under the Planning Act 2008 (the "2008 Act") for a Development Consent Order (DCO). If made, the DCO would grant consent for the A47 Wansford to Sutton Scheme (the "Scheme").
- 1.1.2 The Scheme comprises the alteration of an existing highway by way of an upgrade to an existing 2.5km of single carriageway between Wansford and Sutton. It will include building a new dual carriageway, partly to the north and also to the south of the existing A47 plus a free flow link from the A1 southbound' improving traffic flow and reducing congestion on the route. A detailed description of the Scheme can be found in Chapter 2: The Proposed Scheme of the Environmental Statement (ES) (TR010039/APP/6.1). This Plan covers the Scheme in its entirety.
- 1.1.3 The Location Plan comprises part of a suite of application documentation and is included in the application in compliance with Regulation 5(2)(o) of the Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedure) Regulations 2009 (the "2009 Regulations") which requires:
 - 5(2)(o) ".... any other plans, drawings and sections necessary to describe the proposals for which development consent is being sought, showing details of design, external appearance and the preferred layout of buildings or structures, drainage, surface water management, means of vehicular and pedestrian access, any car parking to be provided, and means of landscaping".
- 1.1.4 Although Regulation 5(2)(o) does not expressly mention location, the Inspectorate's Advice Note Six: Preparation and submission of application documents (February 2016: Version 7) suggests (at Appendix 1) that an application for development consent may include the submission of a location plan.
- 1.1.5 This Plan therefore has been included in the application to identify the location of the Scheme in its wider geographical context. As a consequence, the Plan uses a smaller scale than that prescribed in Regulation 5(3) of the 2009 Regulations but only so the wider geographical context can be represented on a single sheet plan.
- 1.1.6 As the Plan is part of the application documents, it should be read alongside and is informed by the other application documents.
