

In principle, Anglian Water are agreeable to the compulsory acquisition of part of their access road and the subsequent return. However, Anglian Water would like to agree the specification of their new access road with National Highways, prior to formally agreeing.

Anglian Water's site is also subject to a temporary acquisition. This poses increased concern for Anglian Water as the site is operational 365 days per year. Any temporary acquisition needs to be discussed prior to National Highways occupation to ensure that the site is suitably secure, Anglian Water's access is not blocked at any time, and there is no or controlled use of chemicals and hazardous substances on Anglian Water's site. To ensure compliance a licence or lease for the duration of National Highways occupation is desired.

National Highways have been approached for a meeting by Anglian Water's agent Savills to agree the approach with Anglian Water.
